We need GA Tech's students, staff and faculty to make Earth Day a success. Volunteer for at least 1 hour and get a free T-shirt!

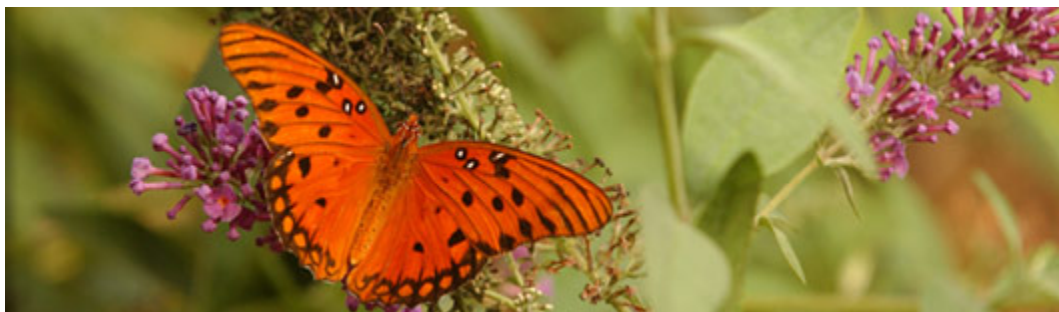
